FRESHI FILM CAMP

For the second year, the Freshi Film Camp returns to the John Anson Ford Amphitheater in Hollywood. The FiF Film Camp offers an immersive filmmaking program for emerging artists 8-18 years of age. Every day is packed with personal appearances by industry professionals, hands-on workshops in a variety of skills and actual experience in narrative filmmaking.

Working within a production team, every participant will complete a short narrative film that will be screened on the final day of the program. All of the equipment necessary to shoot a film is provided. The day begins at 10 AM and ends at 4 PM. Lunch and snacks are included in the fees. Each 5 day Film Camp is \$485 and the application form is on the website.

FRESHI FILM FESTIVAL

The FiF Festival is on July 21, 2007 at the Raleigh Studio in Hollywood, California. The Festival is a full day of film screenings, the FiF Screenwriters Showcase, workshops, face-to-face encounters with film professionals, and hand-on training sessions in the latest skills and technology for the film industry.

The films and screenplays are submitted by young talent 8-18 years of age from around the world. The deadline for submission is June 15 for both the screenplays and the short films. The cost of submission is \$25 for either a film or a screenplay. Finalists are announced on July 1, 2007 and all Finalists will be screened at the Festival. For the Finalist screenwriters, excerpts from their scripts will be performed in a staged reading by professional actors. This event is called the Screenwriter's Showcase and it provides an opportunity for a writer to hear his/her words read out loud and to have an audience respond. Films are accepted in the following categories: Drama, Comedy, Animation, Documentary, and Educational. The Screenplay categories are Drama, Comedy, Animation and Sci-Fi/Adventure.

The price of admission is \$10 which includes a bag lunch and unlimited access to every aspect of the festival. The event culminates at the Awards Ceremony when the winning screenplays and films are announced.
